ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Co-founded by Dan and Margaret Duckhorn in 1976, Duckhorn Vineyards has indisputably established itself as one of the finest and most respected wine producers of the United-States. From its modest inaugural vintage of 800 cases of Cabernet Sauvignon and 800 cases of Merlot in 1978 to its addition of Sauvignon Blanc in 1982, Duckhorn Vineyards has crafted a tradition of quality and excellence that continues today under Head Winemaker Renée Ary.

WINEMAKING

2019 brought another exceptional vintage to Napa Valley, resulting in wines with alluring polish and poise. While there was a slightly later-than-normal start to the season, ideal summer weather with no significant heat spikes ensured ideal flavour development, yielding refined reds with elegant tannins, enticing aromatics and beautiful fruit flowers. This wine has been aged for 16 months in 100% French oak 50% new and 50% neutral.

TASTING NOTES

Beautifully rich and complex, this wine offers enticing aromas of huckleberry jam, black cherry and cinnamon spice, with hints of bay leaf, maple and violets. The lush dark berry and sweet baking spice notes are echoed on the palate, where the flavours are framed by a firm underlying structure and fine, dusty tannins that add depth and nuance to a long, robust finish.
