ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Founders, Dan Kosta and Michael Browne started out with humble beginnings while working together in a local restaurant in 1997. Full of passion, Michael developed relationships with key growers in Northern California, while Dan along with the help of a third partner, Chris Costello, worked to market and sell the wines. Kosta Browne has a commitment to embrace innovation, and to push boundaries. The winery use unconventional approaches in the cellar to make irresistible wines with a sense of place.

WINEMAKING

Made from five clones and fermented in an array of stainless steel, concrete, and wood vessels, the 2020 Gap's Crown Vineyard Pinot is as exuberant as it is irresistible, revealing layers of sun-kissed blackberry, cedar, and spices. The soil type is loam and clay. Fermented in 71% stainless steel, 22% wood, 7% concrete and 2% whole cluster. This wine is aged in 48% new French oak for 15 months and 2% new Austrian oak for 15 months, prior to bottling 100% aged in stainless steel for one month.

TASTING NOTES

Soft and silky, its dark fruit flavours flow across the palate, underscored by velvety tannins, finishing with a wealth of energy, drive, and power. Bursting with fresh-picked blueberries, blackberries, baking spices, and lifted vanilla aromatics. An iconic palate with dark fruit flavours underscored by elongated velvety tannins. A finish with a wealth of energy, drive, and power.
