## **ABOUT THE DOMAINE**

Founders Dan Kosta and Michael Browne started out with humble beginnings while working together in a local restaurant in 1997. Full of passion, Michael developed relationships with key growers in Northern California, while Dan along with the help of a third partner, Chris Costello, worked to market and sell the wines. Kosta Browne has a commitment to embrace innovation, and to push boundaries. The winery use unconventional approaches in the cellar to make irresistible wines with a sense of place.

## WINEMAKING

Fermentation occurs in 77% stainless steel, 13% wood, 10% concrete and 2% whole cluster. This wine is aged in 34% new French oak for 15 months and 14% wood cask for 15 months. The soil was mainly Goldridge loam.

## **TASTING NOTES**

On the nose, this wine has enchanting aromatics delight with pronounced blackberry and layers of ripe red cherry and raspberry. The palate is silky smooth with delicate tension and a remarkable finish.
