### ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Adelphi is regarded as the ultimate independent Single Malt Scotch Whisky bottler in the world. Established in 1826 on the banks of the river Clyde in what is now the heart of Glasgow, the independent Adelphi Distillery adheres to strict standards of excellence, purity and rigour. Only the very best single malt casks available are selected under the meticulous scrutiny of a panel of “noses” chaired by celebrated whisky authority Charles MacLean. Only the very best barrels are chosen from the distilleries. All whiskies are bottled straight from the cask without the addition of artificial colouring and without chill-filtration.

### DISTILATION

A particularly spicy Glenrothes here, distilled in 2007 and rested in a single refill sherry butt for 13 years. In 2021 it was bottled by the ever-brilliant Adelphi, with a release of 604 bottles at 59.8% ABV.

### TASTING NOTES

On the nose, there are aromas of baking spice galore, balanced by chocolate spread on toast, and dried apricot. On the palate there are flavours of candied ginger, clove-studded orange, and raspberry jam. With a finish of oak spice appears on a warming finish, with a burst of bramble fruit.
