ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Adelphi is regarded as the ultimate independent Single Malt Scotch Whisky bottler in the world. Established in 1826 on the banks of the river Clyde in what is now the heart of Glasgow, the independent Adelphi Distillery adheres to strict standards of excellence, purity and rigour. Only the very best single malt casks available are selected under the meticulous scrutiny of a panel of “noses” chaired by celebrated whisky authority Charles MacLean. Only the very best barrels are chosen from the distilleries. All whiskies are bottled straight from the cask without the addition of artificial colouring and without chill-filtration.

DISTILATION

Distilled at Inchgower in 2010 and matured in a single cask for a dozen years, this single malt joins the collection from indie bottler Adelphi. A total outturn of 512 cask-strength bottles was released in 2023.

TASTING NOTES

Drawn from a refill sherry butt with a summer gold colour and medium bead. The nose delivers dry roasted peanuts, pecan ice cream, aromatic wood, gummy bears, curry powder, cardamom, green peppercorn, bay leaf, incense, burnt butter, hazelnuts, and cured bacon aromas. On the palate, there are flavours hickory, savoury roots, raisins, tagine, zatar, sumac with a viscous decidedly sherry cask medium finish.
