ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Started at a very young age, Alexis founded his estate in 2015, and now at 25, without a doubt, he is a rising star of the Burgundy wine scene! Located in Fuisse, the winery has been in the family for five generations, after having completed his viticulture degree, Alexis took over the estate when he was only twenty years old.

WINEMAKING

With incredible attention to detail, Alexis cultivates all his small parcels while adhering to a viticulture philosophy focused on biodiversity. He achieves this through the use of organic manures, cover crops, herbal treatments, and the introduction of apiculture to naturally tackle insects in the vineyards with the help of bees. These practices enable the vines to thrive and produce exceptional, distinctive quality fruit in a natural manner. The wine is fermented partially in stainless steel tank (80%) and in oak barrels (20%). For the 2021 vintage, the region experienced a mixed growing season, with a relatively warm and dry spring followed by a cooler, wetter summer. This resulted in a delay in the start of the growing season and lower yields compared to previous years. However, the grapes that were harvested showed good ripeness levels and balanced acidity. The average age of the vines is 45 years.

TASTING NOTES

On the nose, it exudes zesty aromas, with hints of citrus fruits and a touch of creaminess. On the palate, it offers a refreshing acidity that gives way to a beautiful array of citrus flavours, with subtle hint of bread crumbs, aromas. The finish is crisp and round, leaving a pleasant zesty sensation.
