ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Louis Max was founded in 1859, in Nuits-Saint-George, and today Theodore Max is the proud owner of over 230 hectares of vineyards. Louis Max's spirit of adventure and viticultural exploration captivated the renowned Burgundian winemaker, David Duband, whose paths crossed with the Louis Max team in 2013. The resulting alliance between premium winemaking know-how and the historical expertise of Maison Louis Max, as both a wine merchant and fellow champion of organic farming, has led to an atypical and exciting take on the two legendary Burgundian grape varieties: Pinot Noir and Charodonnay, in the South of France.

WINEMAKING

The expression of Pinot Noir, an emblematic Burgundy grape variety on terroirs of the South of France. The vines for this wine are located on a relatively steep slope, with deep clay-limestone soil, facing northwest and northeast. The vinification is traditional in stainless steel tanks for maximum freshness. It is made in a Burgundy style, expressing the grape variety in a great freshness and lightness.

TASTING NOTES

This wine has a beautiful ruby red colour with aromas of black and red berries, fresh grapes and notes of pepper. It is an elegant, delicate and fruity wine with a good length.
