ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Maison Gérard Boyer is a seven-hectare property located mainly in Côte de Beaune, in the commune of Meursault. Winegrowers for five generations, the domaine has constantly evolved. Gérard Boyer took over the reins in the 1980s, and modernised traditional winemaking approaches, developed a network of customers and acquired new appellations by the 2000s. Maison Gérard Boyer cultivate vines, vinify the grapes and produce the wines with respect for tradition. In order to expand the appellations from Burgundy, the property, also buy some wine cuvées from small winegrowers.

WINEMAKING

Located in the town of Meursault, the family owned Gérard Boyer's estate is made up of approximately 7 hectares. Its plots are located on prestigious terroirs of Burgundy such as: Gevrey-Chambertin, Savigny les Beaune, Chorey les Beaune, Auxey-Duresses and Meursault.

TASTING NOTES

A bright ruby coloured Pinot Noir, which develops in the bottle over time taking on a darker black cherry hue. There are aromas of strawberries, blackberries, violets and hints of spice. On the palate it is full of finesse and rich flavours, it has good structure and great aging potential.
