

## Domaine Gerard Boyer Meursault Blanc 'Les Narvaux'

### ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Maison Gérard Boyer is a seven-hectare property located mainly in Côte de Beaune, in the commune of Meursault. Winegrowers for five generations, the domaine has constantly evolved. Gérard Boyer took over the reins in the 1980s, and modernised traditional winemaking approaches, developed a network of customers and acquired new appellations by the 2000s. Maison Gérard Boyer cultivate vines, vinify the grapes and produce the wines with respect for tradition. In order to expand the appellations from Burgundy, the property, also buy some wine cuvées from small winegrowers.

### WINEMAKING

Short pressing and barrel fermenting for approximately 8 months, with 20% new barrels used. Aged for 8-10 months in stainless steel. The 2020 vintage in Meursault was marked by a difficult growing season due to the impact of frost and mildew. Yields were significantly reduced, but those who were able to manage these challenges produced wines with good concentration and balance.

### TASTING NOTES

The colour is bright. The nose gives off delicate aromas of butter, citrus, and spices. The palate is full, round, and rich, supported by subtle oak and well-balanced acidity.
