ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Maison–Gutowski aims to create products whose ambition lies simply in their quality: a rosé wine with a base of pleasure for lovers of good taste, simply wishing to indulge themselves. Maison Gutowski is a work of passion from Franco-Swiss entrepreneur Aline Gutowski, who released her first vintage in 2016. Maison–Gutowski wanted to benefit from the diversity of Provence soils thanks to the formation of the Massif des Maures. The shale soil brings all the strength and minerality of the terroir, the clay-limestone reveals all the freshness, the expression of the fruit and the elegance of the South.

WINEMAKING

In the centre of the Var region, Provence, benefiting from a limestone and dolomitic massif. Some plots are at slight altitude (400m) on clay-limestone soil, particularly rich for vines. Night harvest. Short skin maceration before pneumatic pressing. The juice is settled at low temperature. Alcoholic fermentation is thermoregulated and malolactic is blocked. Vinification takes place in stainless steel vats under temperature control, with all stages taking place protected from air.

TASTING NOTES

A pretty floral bouquet mixed with notes of yellow fruits (peach, apricot) and citrus. A beautiful palate which brings all its freshness to this light and dynamic rosé. We find the same fruity notes as those present on the nose. A fragrant and light wine perfect for sharing with ease.
