ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Paraduxx was created to allow the Duckhorn Vineyards' winemakers the freedom to explore other styles without detracting from the winery's focus on Bordeaux varietals. Founded by Dan and Margaret Duckhorn, Paraduxx has earned acclaim as the only California winery solely devoted to Napa Valley blends. Winemaker, Cardiff Scott-Robinson, creates visionary blends that capture the essence of their Napa Valley terroir. Cardiff is recognized for embracing the artistry of creating exceptional contemporary blends with a mastery of multiple grape varieties gained on two continents.

WINEMAKING

This wine has been aged 18 months in 100% French oak 40% new, 60% second vintage.

TASTING NOTES

Deep, dark and luxurious, this wine offers alluring aromas of blackberry, black cherry, blueberry, currant and cocoa powder, with underlying hints of saddle leather, cinnamon and clove. The voluptuous dark berry notes are echoed on the palate where they are framed by supple tannins and sophisticated layers of anise, vanilla, sweet tobacco leaf and freshcracked black pepper, all of which carry the wine to a juicy dark berry finish.
