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ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Peccavi is a small boutique vineyard located in Western Australia, in the 'sweet spot' sub-region of the Yallingup ridge, in the north of the Margaret River region. All the Peccavi Wines are estate grown, handpicked, handcrafted and see only the finest French oak. Peccavi is notably one of the first Australian vineyards to have the same new clones being used by the greatest Estates of Bordeaux. The Estates viticulture practices encourage vine roots to dive deep into ancient granite, ultimately concentrating flavours in the fruit and adding natural mineral characters to the finished wines. Today, owner and founder of Peccavi wines, Jeremy Muller, produces wines which offer beautiful structure, balance and aroma complexity throughout a range of whites and reds.

WINEMAKING

The 2019 Chardonnay underwent only partial malolactic conversion and was matured in 30% new Burgundy barrels for 11 months with regular lees stirring.
