This wine reflects the character of its roots yielding a beautifully concentrated, well-structured wine with layers of depth and complexity. Paso Robles Wine Country is centrally located between San Francisco and Los Angeles along California's Central Coast. With a greater day-to-night temperature swing than any other appellation in California, distinct microclimates, diverse soils, and a long growing season, Paso Robles is a unique wine region blessed with optimal growing conditions for producing premium and ultra-premium wines. A gifted winemaker, Katie Povah brings a deep and nuanced understanding of the Paso Robles wine region and strives to express the luxurious power and complexity of great Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINEMAKING

Aged 18 months in 100% French oak, 40% new, 60% neutral. The vintage began with a cool winter, with late rains, followed by a mild spring and early summer. The late-summer heat also spurred the Cabernet Sauvignon to an early harvest.

TASTING NOTES

Showcasing the juicy dark fruit and velvety tannins that make the finest Paso Robles Cabernets so alluring, this wine begins with enticing aromas of raspberry compote, plum jam and sassafras, along with oak-inspired notes of vanilla and molasses from barrel aging. On the generously structured palate, lavish berry flavours lead to layers of chocolate and clove, with hints of warm baking spice emerging during a long, dramatic finish.
