ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Trois Noix is French for 'three nuts', and is a homage to Founder, Jaime Araujo's love of France, and the commitment to using wine as a catalyst for social change. Trois Noix was founded in 2013 and was born out of a lifelong love of wine. Standing on that foundation today, this Estate is a bridge between "Established Napa" and "Next Napa," holding onto that sense of place while inviting as many people as possible to revel in their shared love of wine. While Trois Noix push the boundaries, they retain tradition in their winemaking. They make wines that are enjoyable and pleasurable – fresh, precise, and approachable with structure to last.

WINEMAKING

In 2019 the Napa Valley experienced a relatively mild summer which was followed by nearly perfect temperatures for fall which allowed fruit to develop lovely complexity of flavours. This wine has been aged for 18 months in 100% new and neutral French oak.

Alcohol by volume 14.9%

TASTING NOTES

Aromas and flavours of black raspberries, strawberries, dried flowers and herbs with hints of roasted red bell pepper and spice. Silky tannins and a lengthy finish. A balanced red wine perfect for pairing with mushroom risotto, plum-glazed duck breast, or your favourite cheese board.
