ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Nikolaus (Nik) Weis is the third generation of the Family to tend vines since the St. Urbans-Hof estate was founded in 1947. Nikolaus was awarded the prestigious title "Oekonomierat" (Chancellor of Agriculture) in 1969 for his dedication to the wine culture of the country. Nik has established St. Urbans-Hof as one of the leaders in quality and innovation among German wineries. The estate produces year after year Rieslings that capture the individual terroirs of the estate's vineyard sites. To achieve intense and well-structured wines, yields are kept at low levels, grapes are harvested as late as possible and all grapes are handpicked and carried from the vineyard in traditional shoulder-mounted containers. Their highest priority is to maintain the ecological balance of the vineyards, led by their strong recognition of the fragile unity of viticulture and nature.

WINEMAKING

Fermented with wild yeasts. Aged in German oak barrels of 1000L. The average age of the vines are 66 years old.

TASTING NOTES

A dry Riesling with a deep structure and elegance. Its spicy bouquet matches perfectly with the flavours of citrus, grapefruit, ripe peaches and Golden Delicious apples. The round and mineral character is truly leading the aromatic complexity of this wine, while a fresh acidity structure keeps the wines finesse. Food pairings; veal dishes, sea food, poultry as well as refined pasta and risotto dishes are recommended.
